

Kids On Track CHARACTER CLUB Program Guidelines

1. Character Club is a program where Kids On Track staff and volunteers go into schools to provide an after school program once a week. Any child grades 1-6 may attend. There is no fee for this program.
2. All children attending any Kids On Track program must have a registration form signed by the **parent/legal guardian** the first time they attend. You can download extra forms at www.kidsontrack.org
3. Please discuss appropriate behavior and the consequences of inappropriate behavior with your child. The following behaviors are expected and if not demonstrated will be addressed with consequences including: time outs, loss of rewards, calls home, week's suspension, or a permanent suspension.

Kids On Track Program Rules:

- * Respect Others: No name calling, hitting, or bullying behaviors.
 - * Respect Leaders: Listen and obey what they say.
 - * Respect Equipment and the Facility: Use the equipment safely and appropriately. Help clean up.
4. The club time contains singing, stories, puppets, and engaging learning times. The emphasis in the clubs is on building Christian character through both the activities and mentorship provided. Bible stories, Scripture verses, Christian songs, prayer, and discussion will be integrated in a friendly, non-coercive manner. Children from any faith background are welcome to attend, however Christian values and beliefs will be presented.
 5. Please check with your school for the end times for your club. Parents are expected to pick up their children promptly at the end of Character Club. Many of our club leaders lead another club that same afternoon and are required to get to the other school on time. Thank you in advance for your cooperation in this matter.
 6. Kids On Track does NOT provide lunches for the Character Clubs– FOR ANY CLUBS TAKING PLACE OVER THE LUNCH HOUR, YOU MUST SEND A LUNCH WITH YOUR CHILD.
 7. You or your emergency contact person must be available to be reached during program times. Should your child need to leave the program it is your responsibility to provide an immediate pick up or assume any costs for transporting your child home.
 8. Space in the School Character Clubs is limited. If your child misses two Clubs in a row with no communication from a parent/guardian, the child's name will be removed from the list and another child will take their spot. Please encourage your children to have regular attendance at these Clubs.

Kids On Track offers school Character Clubs free of charge to any child wanting to participate. We are funded through donations from generous supporters. Parents may contribute to the program and receive a charitable tax receipt for their donation.
